# Summer Reading Challenges for English



To prepare yourself for English lessons at Millfield, you will have been given a copy of the novel, 'Can You See Me?' Over summer, you should read this book so that all of year 7 have a shared experience of reading the same novel. Our first few English lessons will be focused on the book as well.

If you would like to complete further activities, why not have a go at some of the challenges below. These **are not compulsory**, but you can hand in any completed challenges to your English teacher, in September, for a reward.

#### Challenge 1: Make a Mask

Tally, the main character in the novel, wears a 'tiger girl' mask to help her deal with difficult situations in her life. Create a mask that you would wear to help you. You could draw and label a mask, describe it with words, or craft a mask.

### Challenge 2: Think Differently

Choose 2 important events from the novel and explain how you would have handled them differently to the characters in the story. Explain how it might have changed the ending of the story.

### Challenge 3: Write All About It

Tally often writes a diary in the novel to help her make sense of what has happened on any particular day. Choose one event from the novel and write a diary entry from the point of view of Nell or Tally's dad instead.

### Challenge 4: All About Me

In the novel, Tally learns a lot about herself. Create a scrap book style picture that would help someone understand who you are: your likes, dislikes, hobbies, pets, family are all things you could include.

We hope that you enjoy reading the novel, and that you have a lovely summer. We are really looking forward to meeting you.
