

Dear Parents and Carers.

I hope that you had a restful summer and spent some quality time with family and friends.

Your children have had an exceptional first week and have quickly settled back into the routines of school. We have unashamedly high expectations and ambition for every child and, as I advised the students in my first assembly this week, all we expect is that they try their best in every lesson and look after one another. I visit lessons every day and it is wonderful to watch students fully engaging with their learning and enjoying being back at



school. Our new Year 7s have already made a fantastic start and have impressed their teachers with their excellent manners, behaviour and attitude to school. Well done to them all! The new upper school core (English, maths and science) forms have also made a great start with their new form tutors, and we are confident this new initiative, receiving 100 additional minutes of tutor time per week, will have a positive impact on the students' GCSE grades.

Our huge variety of lunchtime and after-school clubs are beginning to get underway; please encourage your child to get involved and try something new – you can see what we have on offer on our website.

A reminder that home-learning is set on Synergy; you should log onto this platform to see how your child is learning and achieving in school. Following parent voice last year, we have worked with Synergy so you will also be able to now see the number of positive points your child receives.

Our GCSE and vocational results this year were outstanding; we are incredibly proud of what our class of 2023 achieved – our first year group to benefit from our new curriculum and options model. Their results will, of course, ensure that many doors are opened to them in the future and we wish them all the very best.

May I remind parents that the turning circle at the front of school can be used in the mornings to drop off, but not at 2:50pm to pick-up (unless your child has an injury etc.), as it is too busy. May I also remind parents not to block residents' driveways and take care when parking on the pavements on Belvedere/Alexandra; the Highway Code states you should not park opposite a junction (e.g. opposite Alexandra) and the nearest you can park to a junction is 10 metres (or 32 feet). We do put 'do not park here' reminders out for this reason, and this is to keep our children safe when crossing the busy roads.
